

# REVERSE IMAGE SEARCH ENGINE

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**Abstract :** Reverse Image search engines are those special kind of search engines where the user don't need to input any keyword to find pictures. Instead, you must put a picture and the engine finds the images like one you entered. Thus, you can get to know everything you wish to, just with the help of one picture.

Google images is a widely used website to search images. Introduced 15 years ago, Google images have the largest database than most of the other sites. In June 2011, Google Images introduced the feature of reverse image search. The mechanism of reverse photo search here is via uploading an image from your computer or pasting the link of the image in the search bar itself, it works equally well both ways, or you can simply drag and drop the image in search bar. Google images use algorithms based on various attributes like shape, size, colour and resolution to get the similar pictures.

The goal of this project is to create a basic image search engine. This search engine is localized and based on images that are indexed by the user. For this project, I have indexed photos and then calculated the colour histogram of these photos.

Later the user has used an image from one of the 5 locations, calculate the histogram and check for similar images, the goal being getting the images from the same location, in the top 5 result images.

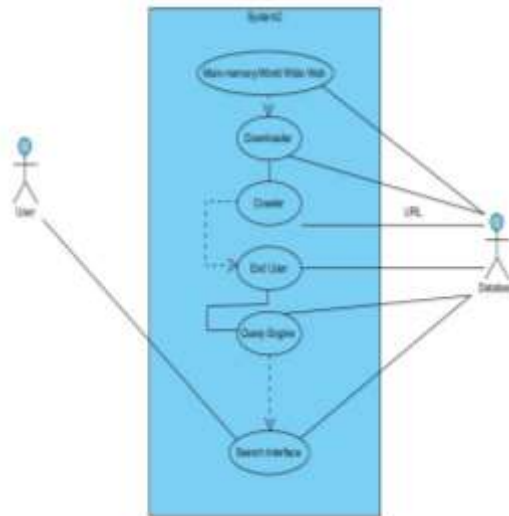


Fig. 1 Architecture Diagram

## III. MODULES

The project is divided into 4 modules as follows:

**Descriptor** – We have used ‘color’ as the main image descriptor.

**Indexing** – The cPickle module that we have used for indexing. “Pickling” is the process whereby a Python object hierarchy is converted into a byte stream, and “unpickling” is the inverse operation, whereby a byte stream is converted back into an object hierarchy.

**Similarity Matrix** - The similarity of 2 images is calculated by using a distance metric. In this case, the chi-squared distance was used.

**Searching** - We apply the descriptor on the query image and then ask your distance metric to rank how similar your images are in your index to your query images. Sort your results via similarity and then examine them.

To run the program successfully, the following packages will have to be installed for Python: a) Numpy b) cPickle c) OpenCV d) Glob e) Tkinter.

### Tkinter:

The Tkinter module (“Tk interface”) is the standard Python interface to the Tk GUI toolkit. Both Tk and Tkinter are available on most Unix platforms, as well as on Windows systems. This Python function will parse the commands and the arguments and convert them into a form that makes them look as if they had come from a Tk script instead of a Python script.

### OpenCV:

OpenCV (Open Source Computer Vision Library) is released under a BSD license and hence it’s free for both academic and commercial use. It has C++, C, Python and Java interfaces and supports Windows, Linux, Mac OS, iOS and Android. OpenCV was designed for computational efficiency and with a strong focus on real-time applications.

### Cpickle:

The pickle module implements an algorithm for turning an arbitrary Python object into a series of bytes. This process is also called “serializing” the object. The byte stream representing the object can then be transmitted or stored, and later reconstructed to create a new object with the same characteristics.
