## **Innovative Methods of Teaching English Language:**

Today's world is a global world with lots of technologies. Communication in English has become mandatory to express intelligence, thoughts and ideas. Students in metropolitan cities don't face much difficulty in communicating in English. But the students from rural background lack skills to communicate in English.

English language teaching (ELT) and literature teaching has occupied greater popularity in the twenty first centaury due to the development of IT and BT sector. English literature occupies greater place in syllabus framing at graduate and post graduate level. American and British literature, Post Colonial literature, Indian Writing in English, English communication skill occupy an important place in the structure of syllabi in India. The teacher is a facilitator in the classroom and build the career of the students. In the age of e-education, traditional method of syllabus structure and teaching method are

Several schemes and policies are introduced to use several devices in higher education system. There are training centres like EFLU in Hyderabad, Regional English Language Training Centre in Bangalore. These are giving several courses like PGCTE, PGDTE, ELT etc. to the teachers to train teachers to teach the students from primary school level to post graduate level.

English syllabus is prescribed in college and university not only to comprehend and appreciate literature but to cultivate the cultural sensitivity and humanistic consciousness. Students must be encouraged to use internet to enhance the understanding of particular text.

In order to avoid ineffective, boring, dull and teacher centric teaching and learning, involve the students in activities and create interest. The students will learn language through experience and experiment. The students presentation and role play are best tools for the students to learn language. For example, if William Shakespeare's King Lear is prescribed for syllabus, teacher has to encourage students to enact the play. The Students must be given background knowledge of the play and audiovideo presentation of the play is presented to the students with the help of internet. Then the students

will be happy to enact the play. They will practice dialogues and rehearsal the scenes and finally present the play. This method will involve nearly twenty to thirty students in a class. Teacher will help the students to solve problems while practicing the play. This method can be used in the study of novels and short stories. The students presentation of a poem will enable them to read analyze and scrutinize the poem. Practical criticism help students to analyze rhythm scheme, metric scheme, rhyme scheme, use of different technique of language and analyze the theme. As students are from different culture and experience they are encouraged to look at a piece of literature through their outlook, here reader response theory works. Internet will help students to have the wider scope of different cultures.

Conference and seminars are the other ways of learning language. The students must be encouraged to present a paper in conference and seminars. In the classroom mock seminars can be organised. The students must be given the task of paper presentation. This method will encourage the students to read, write and speak their thoughts. Further conference will enable the students to have scholarly writing and reading skills, scholars come together to find a solution through discussion. In conference the students are introduced to different domains like music, art, humanities. The students get exposure and broaden their knowledge through conference, seminar and workshop.

The students must be given the knowledge of the world. They must know why they are reading particular text book. They must analyze that whether the book is particularly helping them in their betterment of life and giving knowledge of society apart from scoring marks in the exams. Hence the outlook of the students and teachers must be changed to look at text and syllabus prescribed for them.
