



# Madarsa Education System: A Case Study Of Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama

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## Abstract

This paper is an attempt to understand the history of Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama, Lucknow with comprehension its vision and mission. Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama, Lucknow is renowned all over the world for its great contribution in the field of education and especially in the field of Islamic studies, Arabic and Diniyat etc. While during the freedom struggle in India, the contribution of Madrasas and Ulamas also cannot be ignored and removed from history. Since the establishment of Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama, a large number of Ulamas have been passed out through which this madarsa is contributing to academics across the world and especially to India. As things have been constantly changing with time, therefore, the madrasa is also in need of change as per the need for time in its curriculum to meet the requirements of the current scenario and twenty-first century. Currently, English is already a part of the curriculum but modern sciences, Mathematics and other vocational subjects should also be given due space and focus for the benefit of society from a larger perspective. There are thousands of Madrasas rendering their services in India and millions are ongoing across the world and largely contributing to academia.

**Foundation:** Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama was established on 26 September 1898 with the aim to bring all the sects of Islam together irrespective of some of their differences in beliefs. It accommodates a diverse range of both scholars and students including Hanafis, Shafi'is and Ahle-Hadith. While the Hanafis form the majority of the students as well as scholars of the respective institution. Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama (translated as, Assembly of Scholars University) not only focuses on the Islamic curriculum but also on modern sciences, mathematics, and vocational training with a special focus on the English language. It is also one of the very few institutes in India to teach the Islamic Sciences completely in Arabic. The manager

of Nadwatul Ulama also serves as the chancellor of Darul Uloom. Presently, Rabey Hasani Nadwi is the chancellor while Saeed-ur-Rahman Azmi Nadvi is the principal of Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama.

**Campuses:** Earlier, Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama used to operate solely from its main campus at Hasanganj, Lucknow but with an increase in intake of students and space constraints at the main campus, two new campuses (at Lucknow) were added to accommodate the students. The new campuses are located at Sikrauri and Mahipatmau which come under Kakori Nagar Panchayat of Lucknow, U.P. Sikrauri and Mahipatmau campuses are situated at a distance of 1.8 km from each other and approx. 12 km from the main campus. It was found that more than 135 madrassas across India are affiliated with Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama.

**Admission:** Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama's admission process starts on the 6<sup>th</sup> of Shawwal (Eid ul Fitr begins with the month of Shawwal) and continues for two weeks. Admission forms must be submitted at Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama before the 25<sup>th</sup> of Shaban (month of Ramadan). If the form is accepted, the student will be called to Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama for an admission test. The admission test is taken based on the previous qualifying class. A successful entrance exam would only allow the student to get admitted to Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama. For admission to 1<sup>st</sup> class, the age range of 6-10 is compulsory.

Apart from the general admissions, a separate oral exam is taken for Hifz-e-Quran (memorising Quran), whose centre is situated at the entrance of Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama. A minimum of 3 parah (chapters) of the Quran must be memorised before appearing for Hifz admission at Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama.

**Attendance:** 75% attendance is compulsory. Warden (in case of hostellers) and principal/superintendent (day scholars) may be granted leave. An absence of 10 days in a row without prior intimation would result in rustication from Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama.

**Hostel:** Hostel facility is available on a payment basis. Hostellers cannot go out without the permission of the warden. The time allotted for going out of campus is on Friday after the Zuhr prayers and before the Maghrib prayers. Students must bring necessities items like clothes, mosquito nets, bed sheets, pillow, cup, plates and dry breakfast items with them. Hostel facility at Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama main campus is available from 6<sup>th</sup> class onwards.

**Student's Council:** There is a student council of Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama called Jamiatul Islah Murabbi, whose head will be nominated by the President himself. This council will help students polish their leadership qualities, oratory skills and organisational aspects.

Without the permission of the rector, students can't participate in Jalsas other than that happening within the campus (once a week, organised by the Students Council). Students are forbidden to invite any foreigner or preachers outside campus for the Jalsa. (Jalsa is a programme where preachers with Islamic knowledge give speeches to the audience on subjects ranging from religious to contemporary issues).

**Arabic Language:** For the promotion of the Arabic language, a separate Arabic department named "Al Nadi Al Arabi" is functioning under the Grammer wing of Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama, who is headed by a Head of Department. Every Thursday, a Jalsa will be organised by the department in which attendance of every student present on the main campus is compulsory.

#### **Important instructions to Students:**

1. A Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama student can't prepare for any other exam. If found, he will be expelled.
2. Namaaz (prayers) in Jamaat is compulsory. Absence without any good cause is punishable.
3. Students must play outdoor games in their hostel ground from Asr till Maghrib.

4. There will be the half-yearly exam of 20 marks while the final exam will be 80 marks. Cumulatively, students must secure 40 marks for promotion to the next class.
5. Kurta Pajama and Sherwani are the official dress at the campus. Shirts and pants are not allowed.

**Fee Structure:** At the time of admission, a security deposit of Rs. 900, development fee Rs. 25, Gym charges- 20, Identity Card- Rs. 25, One Month fee- Rs. 900, Electricity- Rs. 100, Examination Fee- Rs. 100, Library- Rs. 25. **Total= Rs. 2095.** After that Rs. 1200 per month will include course fee and food charges. The canteen facility is available on a payment basis. The fee will be collected before the 5<sup>th</sup> of every month.

The fee for classes 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> is preferably collected via money order at Syedna Abu Bakr Madrassa, Mahipatmau, Kakori, and Lucknow.


A scholarship facility is available for poor students. However, scholarships are given preferably to higher studies students (8<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>) with a particular focus on those students who have a command of the Arabic language. Two teachers/ influential persons in the area must write a citation for the student to get a scholarship. This scholarship will be renewed every year based on the academic, religious and social behaviour of the student. Students bringing citations of influential persons of their area will be given preference. Those offered scholarships will have to give an undertaking that they will not leave Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama before Fazilat (degree course) unless under exceptional circumstances. Scholarships will be recovered if any student is rusticated.

**Classes:** for 6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> class, a total of 5 hrs 40 mins class divided into seven (7) parts each of 50 mins with an interval for Zuhra prayers. For classes 3 to 5, a total of 8 hrs class with 35 mins intervals between two types.

Junior classes (class 1 to 4<sup>th</sup>) and hostel facility are held at Syedna Abu Bakr Madrassa, located at Mahipatmau, kakori Lucknow. Affiliated madrassas also take junior courses. However, a hostel facility is not available in most of these madrassas. Classes 5<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> are held at Sikrauri, Kakori Lucknow.

#### Curriculum:

In the Madrasa education system, Class 1 to 5 are termed as “Ibtidaiyah” classes, for classes 6 to 8- the term “Motawassate” is used, classes 9 to 10 are referred to as “Sanavia”, Class 11-12 is known as “Aalemiyat” and post-class 12 is directed by the term “Fazilat”.





### Tadrib-e-Ifa and Mufti Course

The course for becoming a Mufti is a specialised course which runs along with the Fazilat course. For becoming Mufti, extra syllabus is added in the field of Aqidah, Manhaj and Fiqah. A student becomes a Mufti after getting the Fazilat degree or may continue studying even after getting the Fazilat degree.

Tadrib-e-Ifa is a teacher's training course offered at Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama to prepare teachers in the Madrassa education field. It's a specialised course which is provided after the Fazilat degree. Generally, Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama graduates are preferred for this course; however, there is no hard and fast rule.

### Khusoosi Darjaat (Lateral Entry)

There is a provision at Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama for the students from the formal education system to switch over to the Madrassa education system. Those who have passed class 12<sup>th</sup> or graduate can apply for admission to Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama subjected to the condition that they have knowledge of Urdu, or else they will have to take Urdu classes for one year compulsorily. After passing the Urdu language course, they must study for five years to pass the Fazilat course. After graduation, they are awarded the degree of "In fil Uloomul Islamiya wal Arabiya".

## **Conclusion**

In India, thousands of Madrasas are rendering their services, while millions are ongoing worldwide. These Madarsas are mainly contributing to the field of academia. Even during the freedom struggle, the contribution and role of Madrasas and Ulamas cannot be forgotten and ignored. Unlike other respective madrasas, one madrasa is known as Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama, Lucknow.

Here, Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama is renowned all over the world for its significant contribution in the field of education, and especially in the field of Islamic studies, Arabic and Diniyat etc. Since the

establishment of Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama, many Ulamas have been passed out. They are contributing to academics across the world as well as the development of this country, India.

Indeed things have constantly been changing with time, and change is an integral part of life and the world. Therefore, the madrasa is also in need of change as per the need of time in its curriculum to meet the requirements of the current scenario, and the twenty-first needs change as per the need of time in its curriculum to meet the requirements of the present system and twenty-first century. English is part of the curriculum, but there is a lack of universal education, including modern sciences, Mathematics etc. The Madarsa is currently offering general graduation courses, but not providing professional education to the student, which makes it regressive in nature. As well, the library of the institution is full of books related to different modern education either in psychology, sociology, philosophy, and science but not even a single modern discipline from them is introduced yet in the respective Madarsa. Hence, with religious education other disciplines including modern science, mathematics and vocational subjects should also be given due space and focus on the benefit of society from a larger perspective.
