- To celebrate family's involvement in their child's education.

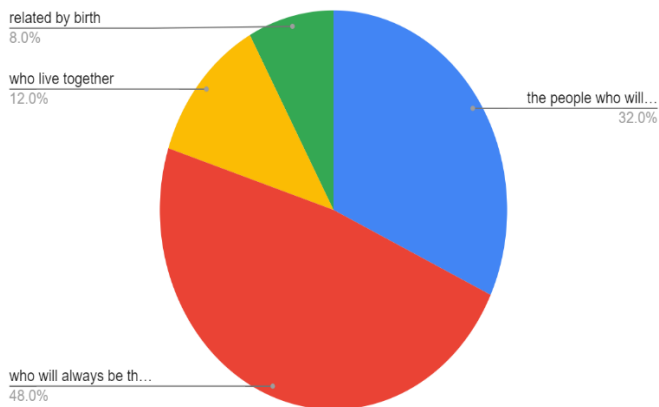

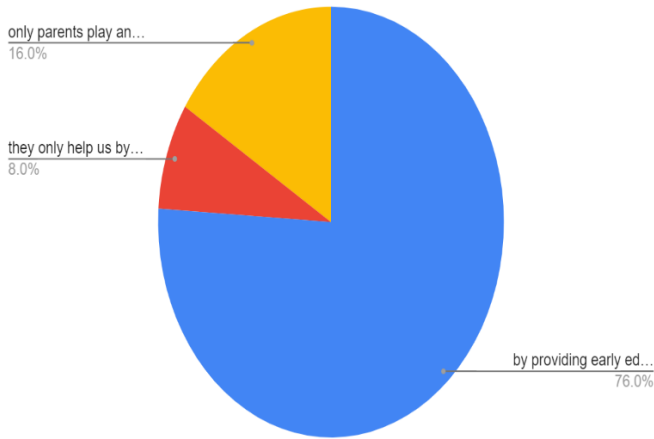

Count of What is family to you?



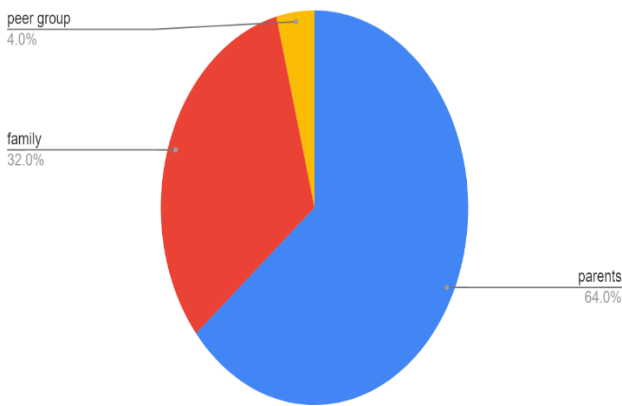

Count of What is the role of family in your education?



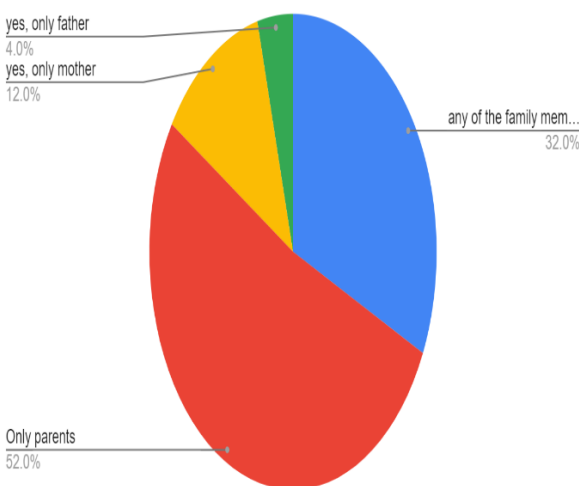

Count of Who motivate you the most to do best in your education?



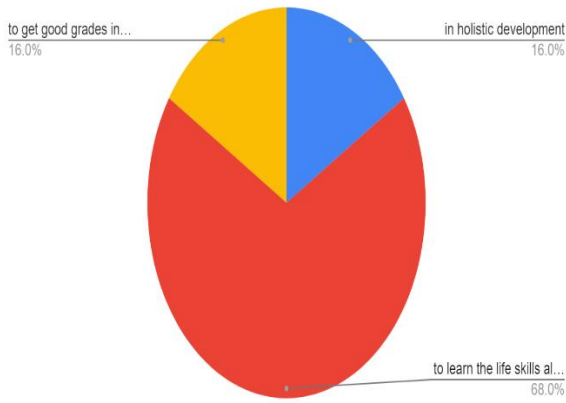

Count of Who monitors your work in your home related to study/education?



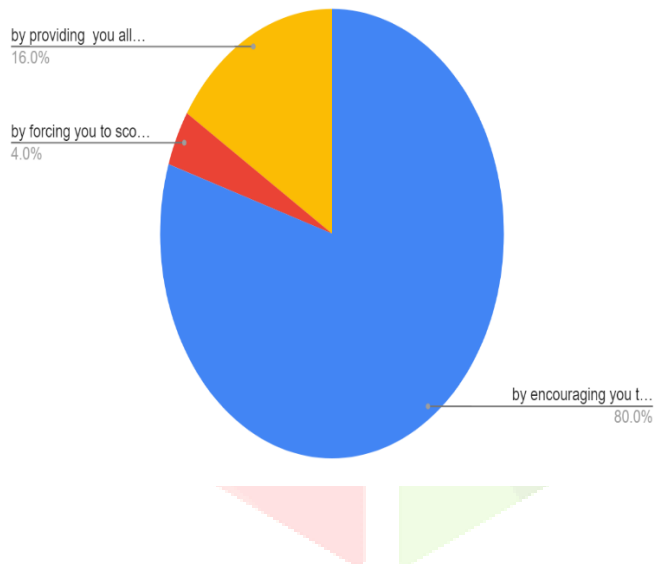

Count of Family members play avital role in education by motivating you



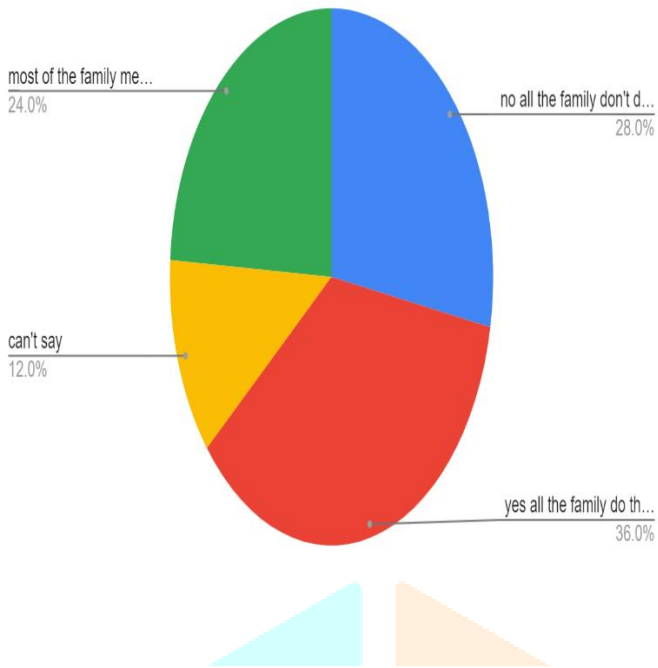

Count of How your family can contribute to your education?



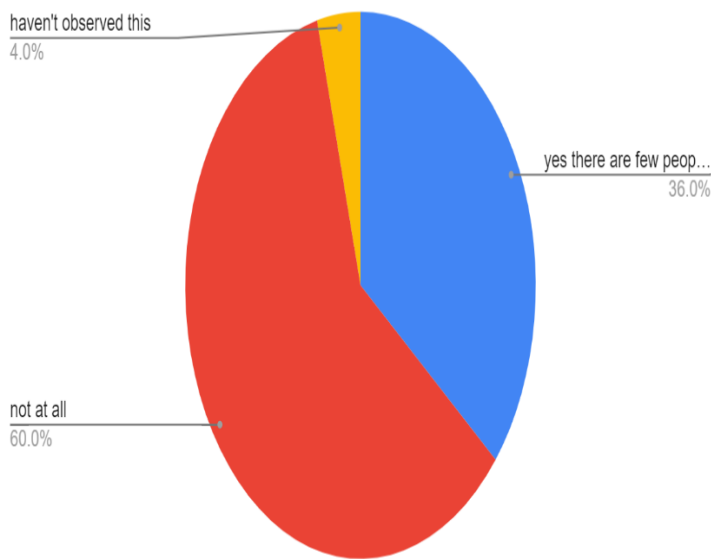

Count of Do all the family members make the same kind of contribution towards providing education to their children?



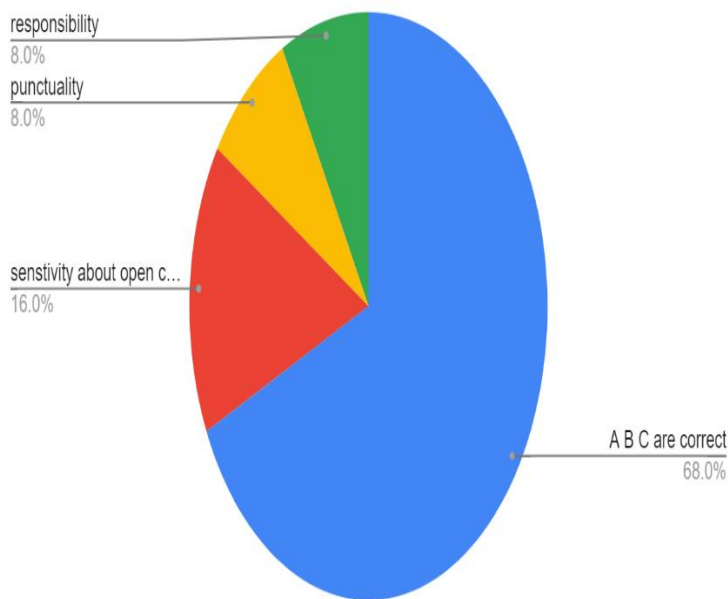

Count of Do you believe that there are few people at our home who ask to stop one gender over other gender from studying...

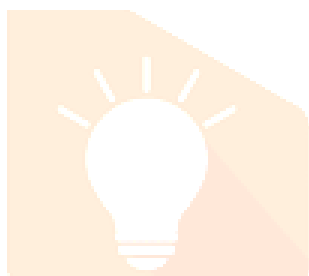

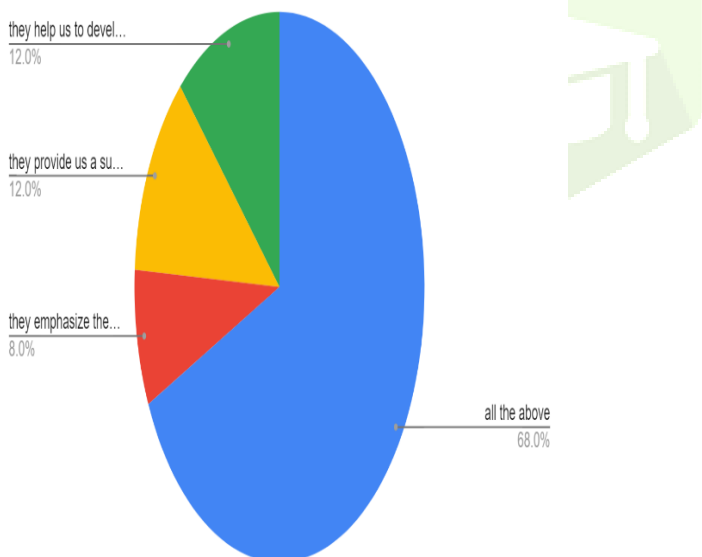
Count of What do you think about the secret of successful educated family?




Count of The role of family in our education is crucial because
