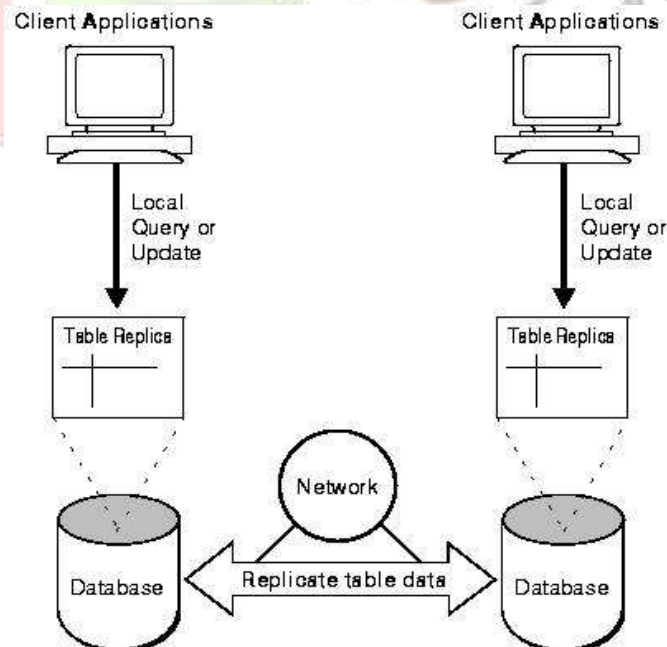


Fig. 1 Replication of Database

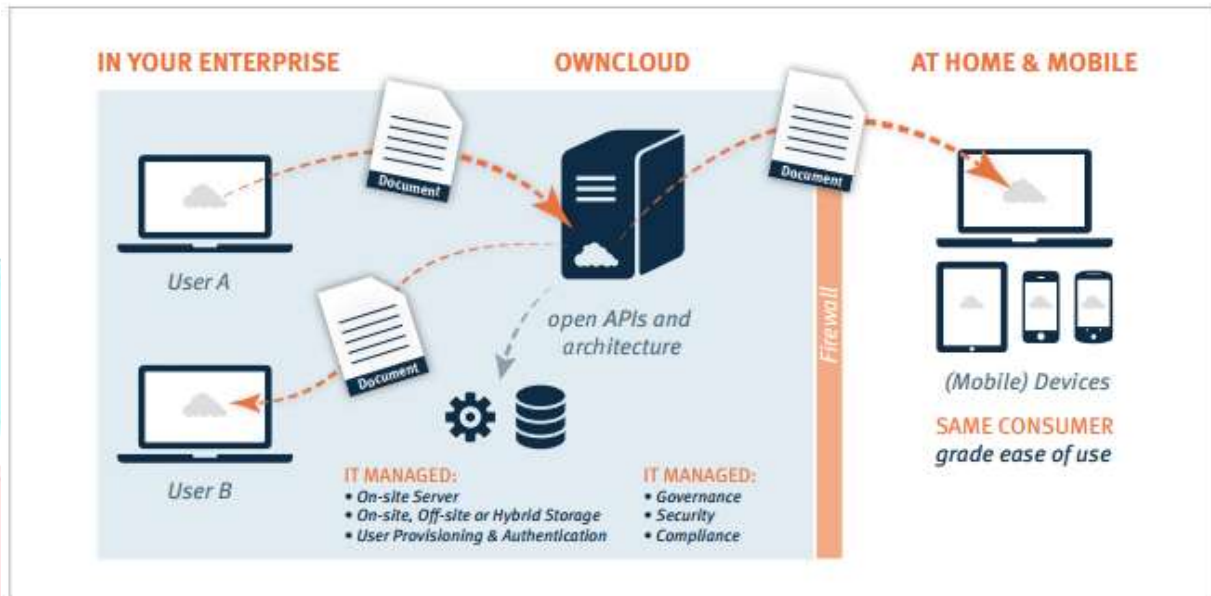


Fig. 2 Proposed System Architecture

1. We will first download the release key associated with the own Cloud software:

3. Finally, update the package database and install own Cloud:

2. Assign privileges to a new MySQL user to handle database operations for ownCloud:

- GRANT ALL ON owncloud.* to 'owncloud'@'localhost' IDENTIFIED BY 'database_password';
- Exit

Login Page Client Side

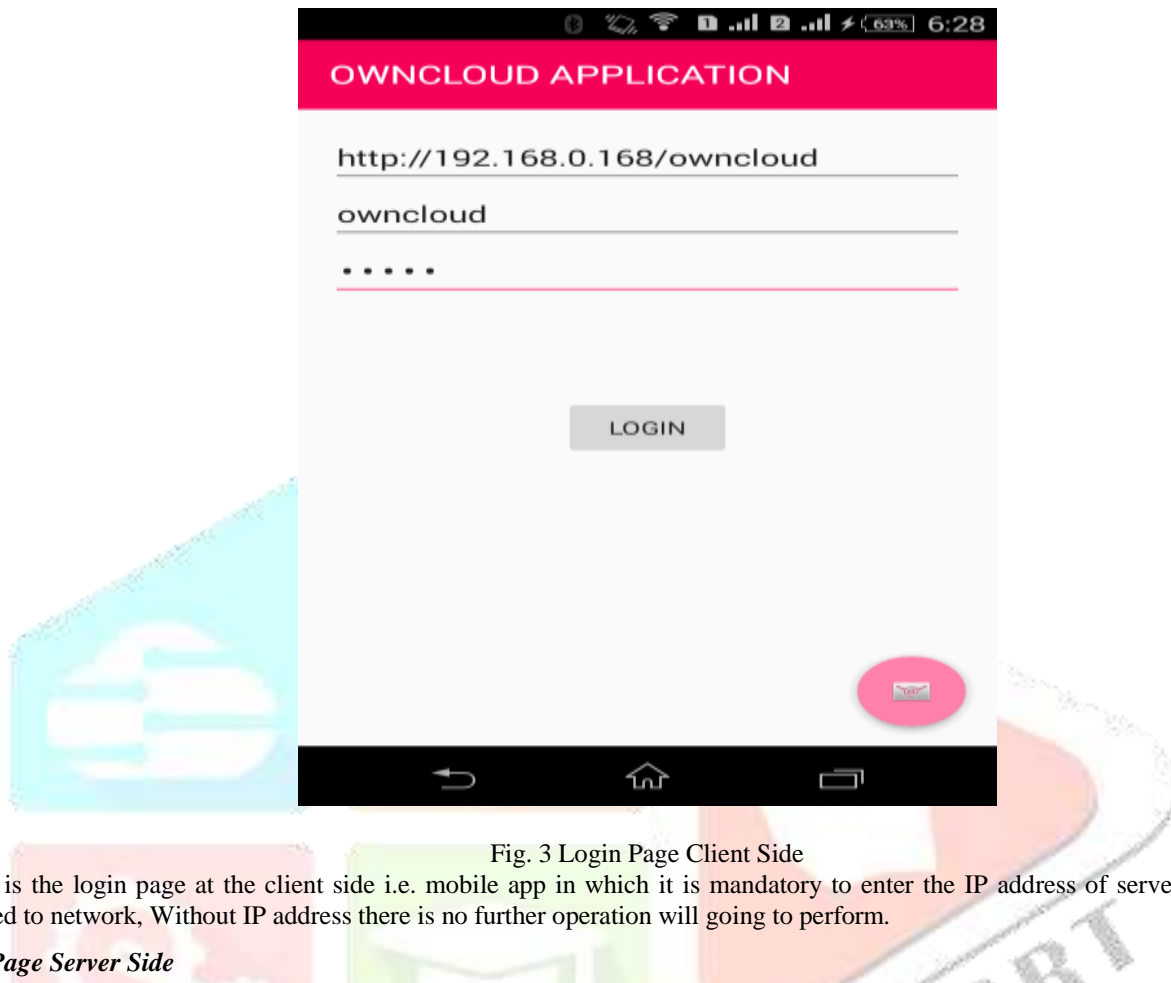


Fig. 3 Login Page Client Side

Login Page Server Side

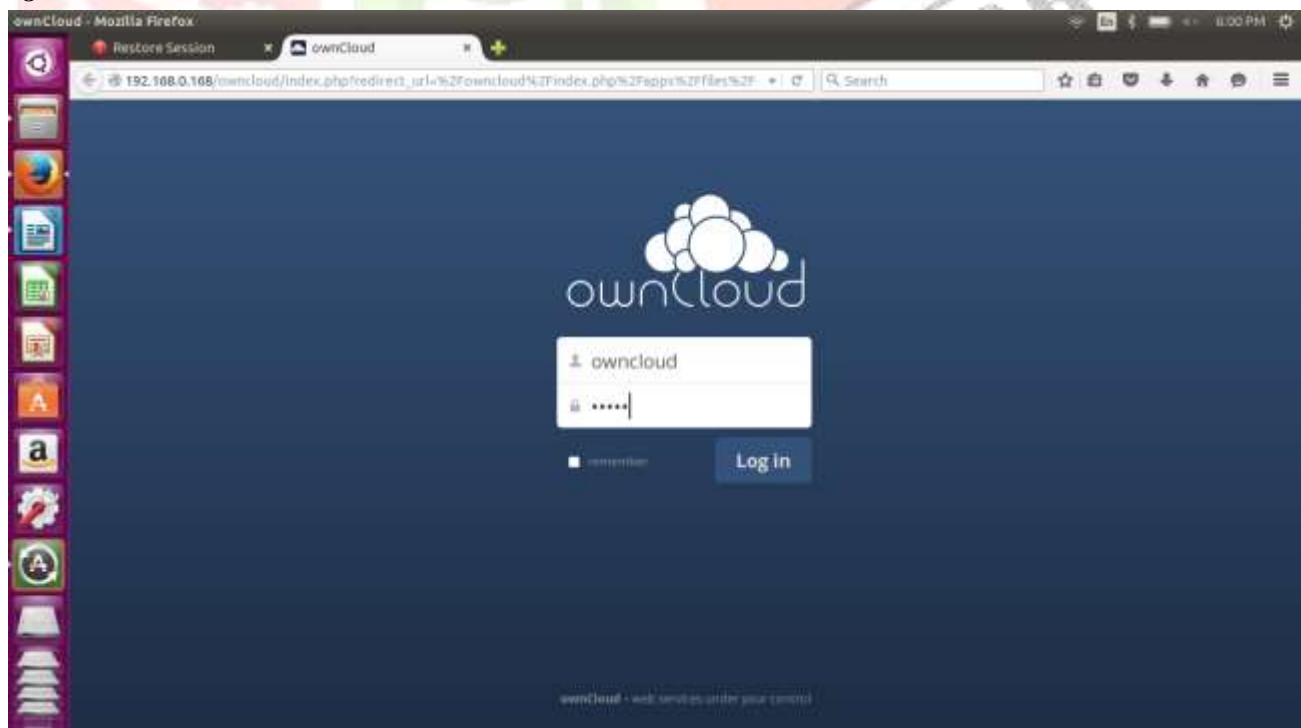


Fig. 4 Login Page Server Side
