Subjects were selected using Simple Random Sampling Method for this study. The researcher selected sports specific personality test Scale for the study. Proper SSPS 20.0 version is used for the analysis of data. The Study found significance difference in some features. The Study revealed that significance difference in sports specific personality.

Statistical tool was used for accurate and systematic results. Independent t-test was use as Statistical Technique for comparative analysis. And the level of significant was set at 0.05 level. Data were analysed by SPSS.


