Belladonna, or the deadly nightshade, was known to the medical world as early as I500 A. D. The Venetians named the plant "herba bella donna," from the circumstance that the ladies used it distilled in water as a cosmetic to brighten the eyes and flush the cheeks.^[2]

Stramonium stands between Hyoscyamus and Belladonna. It excites the sensorium and perverts its functions. The special senses are affected. Double vision; Objects appear double or oblique.^[2]

Botanically and, in one measure, therapeutically, Hyoscyamus is similar to belladonna. This interesting drug, although innocuous to some animals, is toxic to birds, and has received the name henbane. [2]

TABACUM contains several active ingredients, the most important of which is Nicotine. [2]

Dulcamara, or "bitter-sweet", contains a small amount of solanine, in fact, in much smaller amounts than any other member of the group. The tender leaves and twigs have been used to prepare the tincture.^[2]

Capsicum possesses few, if any, of the narcotic properties of the Solanaceae, but it has higher levels of the group's irritating properties; But very little medicine is needed to cause this irritation.^[2]




Figure 1 Showing repertorization Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 2 Showing repertorization from Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 3 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 4 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)

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


Figure 5 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 6 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 7 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 8 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 9 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 10 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 11 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 12 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 13 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 14 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 15 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 16 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 17 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 18 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 19 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 20 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 21 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 22 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 23 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 24 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 25 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 26 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 27 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)




Figure 28 Showing repertorization of Complete Repertory using Cara Professional (Version 1.4)

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
