To study Land use patterns of Hisar

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
RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

The original data were collected from the District Headquarters - Land Record Office, Revenue Office, Irrigation Department, Forest Office, Canal Department and District Census Hand-book of Hisar district. Some useful data of district level were also obtained from the Deputy Director of Agricultural and the District Statistical Office of Hisar district. The data collected from the different places are related with the years 2016-2017. The data of 10 years have been collected for the detailed study of Hisar district. The data used for microstudy of sample villages are obtained from Patwari, Kanoon go, Pradhans and villagers. Some data of these villages were collected on the personal investigation. It is not possible to give the details of all geographical factors of any big region like district, so some villages have been selected for detailed study. On the basis of the detailed study of these villages, some solid conclusions can be drawn. On the basis of these sample work, the total study of the land Utilization has been described in Hisar district.

STUDY AREA

Hisar District is one of the important districts of Haryana State. There are 5 tehsils, 9 development blocks, 11 towns and 269 villages in Hisar district. Five villages have been selected, one each from every tehsil of Hisar district. These five villages are as following:

- I. Rajthal (Narnaud Tehsil)
- II. Jakhod Khera (Hisar Tehsil)
- III. Shekhpura (Hansi Tehsil)
- IV. Sadalpur (Adampur Tehsil)
- V. Babua (Barwala Tehsil)




LAND UTILIZATION IN RAJTHAL




LAND UTILIZATION IN JAKHOD KHERA






