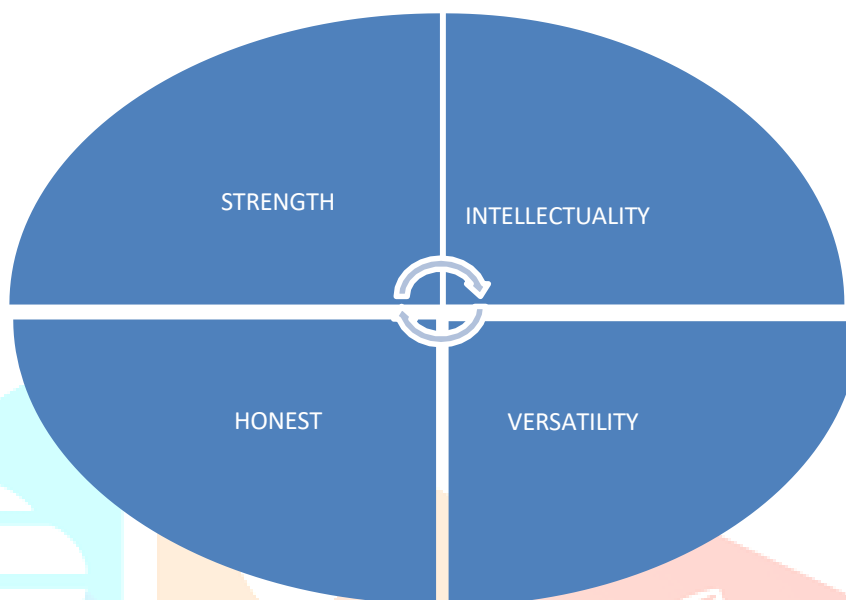

Strength: The strength is related to ability of an individual which could be helpful for him/her to decide a particular target.

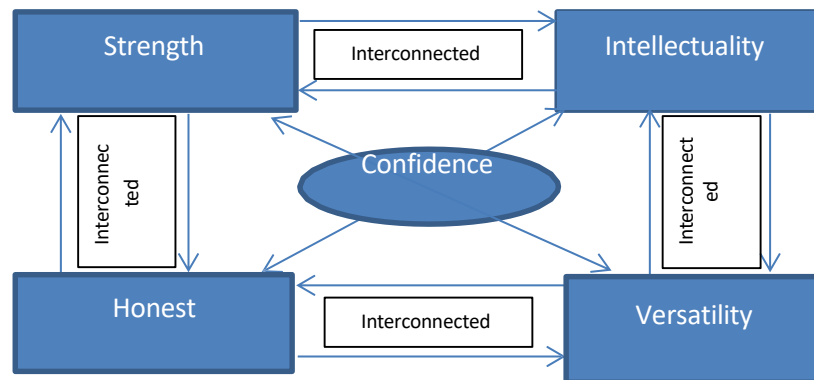
Honest: The honest is related to the dedication of an individual to accomplish the decided task according to the strength along with sovereignty and allegiance.

An omniscient learner requires having a positive attitude because every big assignment requires a team work, without team work a project cannot be accomplished within a time frame along with efficiency.

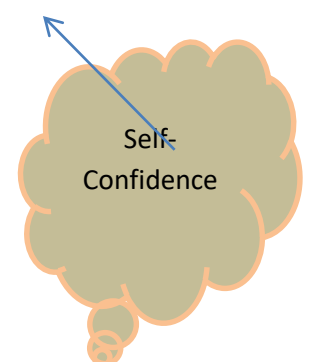

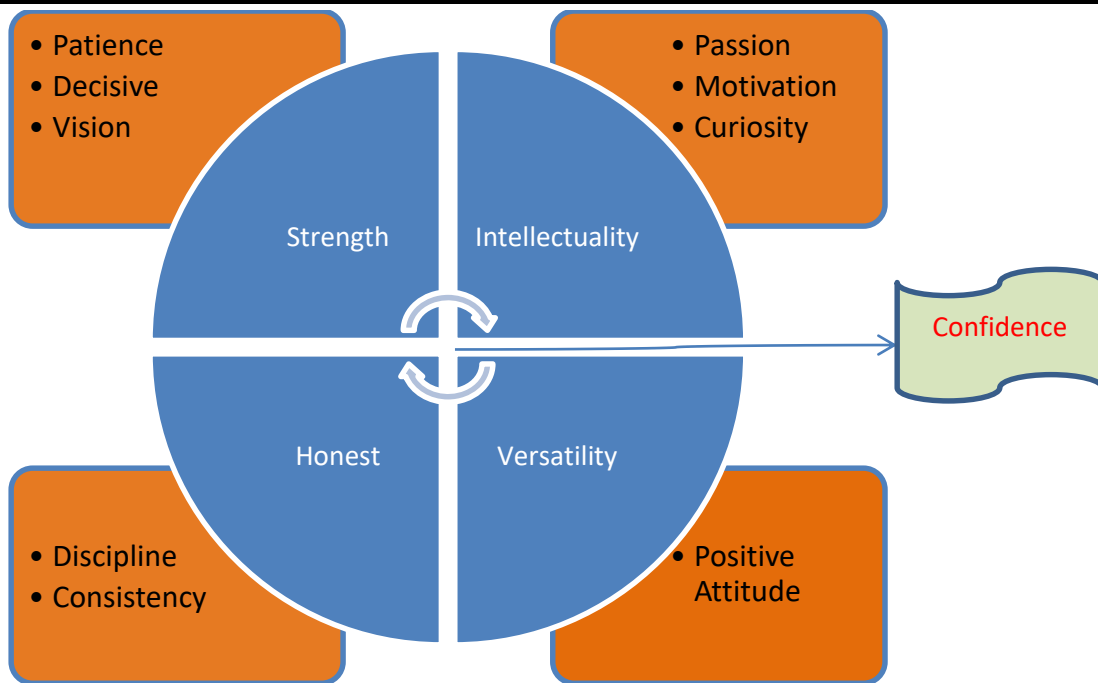
10. Consistency
