## **INTRODUCTION:**

From that time any Materials used to beautification or promoting appearance is known as cosmetic. The word "cosmetics" Actually stems from its use in Ancient Rome. They were typically produced by female slaves known as "cosmetic" which is where the word "cosmetics" stemmed from. Cosmetics are used to enhance appearance. (3) The formulation which contains the herbs are proved by ayurveda. Herbal remedies in rich the bodies with nutrients with other useful minerals. An herbal lotion that can give effective protection to skin and free from any toxicity' A herbal lotion is a liquid preparation, applied externally on the skin to produce orenhance a beautification. Lotions are used for washing the skin and to remove the oily secretions. It increases the blood circulation, emolliency, extended to astringency, skin freshness, bleaching and other medicinal properties. The function of a skin lotion is to opposed to skin against different environmental condition, weather and gives soothing effect to the skin. Herbal Cosmetics, here referred as Products, are formulated, using various permissible cosmetic ingredients to form the base in which one or more herbal ingredients are used to provide defined cosmetic advantages only, shall be called as "Herbal Cosmetics". Lotions are liquid preparations meant for external application without friction. They are applied directly to skin with the help of some absorbent material, such as, cotton wool or gauze soaked in it. #### **EXTRACTION PROCESS OF TOMATO:**

- 1. In a mixer fresh tomato was cut and homogenized.
- 2. A part of the water was distilled off under reduced pressure at  $60 \,^{\circ}$  C And discarded to obtain of tomato concentrate.
- 3. Adequate amount of water saturated was poured into the concentrate, protected from light at Room temperature, and the mixture was stirred for 2 hours.
- 4. After 2 hours, the extract was collected and the residue was extracted.
- 5. The extract was filtered and filtrate is collected.(7)

#### PREPARATION OF ALOVERA GEL:

- 1. Collect the raw material.
- 2. Wash leaf and remove base and tip of the leaf.
- 3. Leaf is cut into section.
- 4. Extract mucilage part of the leaves into mixing jar.
- 5. Heat it and add agar-agar powder.
- 6. Grinding /homogenization of unpasteurized juice.
- 7. Add vitamin E and mix it well.
- 8. Package the produced gel and store it.

### METHOD OF PREPARATION HERBAL LOTION:

- 1. Weigh all the ingredients as per formulation
- 2. Alovera gel was taken in separate clean beaker then stirred it till it gets converted into little bit creamy form.
- 3. Then honey and tomato extract was added and mixed it.
- 4. Then another beaker was taken and in that Almond oil, Lavender oil, Vitamin. Oil from capsules and Glycerin was added.
- 5. Then this oils solution was slowly added in the first one beaker and mixed it thoroughly.
- 6. After mixing all ingredients rose water and coconut milk was added as per consistency.

# 1. Organoleptic character

Colour – Yellowish

Texture –Smooth

State – Semi-solid

## 2. Homogenicity

The formulation were tested for homogeneity by visual appearance and by touch.

## 3. PH determination

0. 5 g cream was taken and dispersed in 50 ml distilled water and then PH was measured by using digital PH meter.

# **4.Stability Test**

To check the microbial growth, the formulation was placed in the center of the petri dish, and then the plates were incubated at 37°C for 72hrs.

# 5. Determination of Spredability

Sample was applied between two glass slides and was compressed to uniform thickness by placing 100gm weight for 5 minutes. Weight was added to the pan. The time required to separate the two slides, i.e. the time in which the upper glass slide moved over the lower slide was taken as measure of spreadability. It was Calculated using the formula:

Spreadability-m\*I/t

m-Weight tide to upper slide, l - Length moved on the glass slide, t-time taken.

# 6. Irritancy test

Mark the area (2 cm2)on the left-hand dorsal surface. Then the cream was applied to that area and the time was noted. Then it is checked for irritancy, erythema, and edema any for an interval up to 24 h and reported.

# 7. Washability

A portion of lotion was applied over the skin of hand and allowed to flow under the forceof flowing tap water for 10 minutes. The time when the lotion completely removed was noted.
